ROLL CALL

Chairman Bailey called the meeting to order at 5:22 p.m. In the absence of the secretary, an acting secretary was proposed. Mr. Mosby was elected as acting secretary.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Mr. Vudragovich moved, seconded by Mr. Cantrell to approve the April 3, 2019 minutes and the motion carried unanimously.

Jose A. Medina and Brenda C. Sanchez were both present to discuss the beer permit application. Sanchez explained that they planned to have 2-3-servers and expected the facility to hold around 60 people. Mr. Cantrell asked how they planned to prevent under age beer consumption. Sanchez explained that they would ID everyone. Mr. Vudragovich asked if there was any outdoor seating and if so, did they plan to install cameras. Mr. Medina explained that all the seating was inside and that they did not plan to install cameras.

Mr. Cantrell asked Brenda Sanchez about her management background and if she had been to classes to learn how to serve alcohol. She explained that she had been a server for over 5-years. Chairman Bailey recommended that the staff attend TIPS training and referred them to ASAP as a resource. He also suggested that if there were any issues to not hesitate to contact ORPD.

Mr. Mosby moved, seconded by Mr. Cantrell, to approve the beer permit application, pending the Life Safety Inspection. The motion carried unanimously (6-0).

Mr. Nelson moved, seconded by Mr. Vudragovich, to approve the manager application. The motion carried unanimously (6-0).
