Staff and attendants will be trained via ABC training prior to the opening date in 30-40 days from the October 6<sup>th</sup> meeting date. Cameras will be in place and parking lot safety will be monitored.

Mr. Whitson suggested they obtain the electronic system to verify ID's. Mrs. Doolittle stressed the importance of ID checks and contacting the police with any concerns and monitoring the parking lot. Mr. Vudragovich shared information on ASAP of Anderson County.
