ROLL CALL

Chairman Bailey called the meeting to order at 5:15 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Mr. Nelson moved to approve the September 4th, 2019 minutes. The motion was seconded by Mr. Cantrell. The motion carried unanimously (5-0).

APPLICATIONS FOR NEW BEER PERMITS AND ASSOCIATED MANAGER APPROVALS

Zandunga Mexican Restaurant (Application 1592 Class C, On-Premises Consumption Permit)

Erika and Christian Munoz were both present to discuss the beer permit application. The new restaurant is still under construction and will be open Monday –Thursday from 11:00am to 10:00pm and Friday & Saturday from 11:00am to 10:30pm and on Sunday from 12:00pm to 9:00pm. They will have 27 tables and around 4-5 servers. They will have a bar area that is sectioned off from the regular dining section. They plan to open sometime in January 2020. The owners previously owned another restaurant for 10-years called Hacienda's. The Chairman brought up that Hacienda's had previously failed inspections. He asked what the owners plan to do differently to keep this from happening at Zandunga's. Erika explained that they have a new person performing the training and because they also have a liquor license they are TIPS trained as well. The Chairman suggested that they contact ASAP for additional training. The Chairman also recommended to follow training, do not over serve and if there are any issues do not hesitate to contact the police department.

Secretary Doolittle moved, seconded by Mr. Cantrell to approve the beer permit application contingent on the life safety inspection. The motion carried unanimously (5-0).
