Ms. Swift was present to discuss her application. Her two sons were also present as they will be employees at the establishment. Ms. Dunn stated the background check information had been returned, however, the life safety inspection was not yet complete.

The Board discussed Ms. Swift's plans for the establishment. Ms. Swift stated she is remodeling the inside a little bit; will not let people enter and exit through the patio; will have about fifty employees with a professional bartender and chef as well as security; will have a family atmosphere; entertainment (bands, etc.) will occur at/after 9pm; and no drugs will be tolerated. Ms. Swift also stated she has twenty cameras in the establishment. The Board discussed "patrolling" the parking lot and encouraged Ms. Swifty's sons to apply for manager approvals. Ms. Swift stated servers will be TIPS trained.

Having no further discussions, Ms. Solmonson moved, seconded by Ms. Doolittle, to approve the applications subject to passage of the life safety inspection and the motion carried unanimously (6-0).
