**ROLL CALL**

Chairman Tedford called the meeting to order at 12:00 noon.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Mr. Avery and Mr. Williamson were present to discuss the application. Chairman Tedford explained that this application was continued from the November meeting in order to give the applicants more time to reach certain goals, especially concerning security measures for the establishment. From the last meeting, Mr. Avery and/or Mr. Williamson, along with their security company representative, were to meet with Deputy Chief Massengill to show proof that a security firm contract was in place and to discuss their security plans. Deputy Chief Massengill reported the establishment nor the security company showed for the scheduled meeting, which was scheduled with Mr. Avery at the November Board meeting. A new meeting date was scheduled with Deputy Chief Massengill for December 28, 2011 at 10:00 a.m.

Mr. Cooksey inquired about the Life Safety Inspection and Ms. Oran stated she thought it been completed but that she would check on it. (NOTE: The Life Safety Inspection was completed on December 21, 2011 per the Community Development Department Code Enforcement Division and the Fire Department.)

Due to unresolved issues, Chairman Tedford moved, seconded by Ms. Solmonson, to continue the application to the January 2012 regular meeting and the motion carried unanimously.

Nang and Tracy Crossno were present to discuss the applications and to ask the Board to waive the one-year prohibition for the location formerly occupied by Shenanigan's whose beer permit was revoked by the Board. The Board and the Crossnos discussed various problems that had occurred under prior ownership and the Crossnos stated they expect a different type of clientele under their ownership. Ms. Heck inquired as to the manager and hours spent on the premises. Mr. Crossno stated he will be on the premises as manager each day after he leaves his other business (Time Out Deli and Hibachi Gallery) which is located adjacent to Brewski's. Chairman Tedford asked about security cameras and the Crossnos stated they had talked to ADT and were also considering cell phone surveillance. When asked if food was available, Mr. Crossno responded they would be serving food from their deli next door.

The Crossnos stated entertainment plans include karaoke, pool, and darts. Deputy Chief Massengill asked about lighting issues. The Crossnos said they are checking into it. Ms. Heck inquired about hours of operation. Mr. Cross responded 11:00 a.m. to 2:30 a.m., and he also said there would be a drink limit policy. Mrs. Crossno stated she would bartend some herself and would be checking IDs closely. When asked about previous parking lot problems, the Crossnos stated they do not want the same clientele and would patrol the parking lot to ensure there are no problems in an effort to not negatively impact their deli and the other businesses located in Grove Center. Chairman Tedford suggested TIPs training for all employees and to be sure to call the police before any problems get out of hand.

There being no further discussion, Chairman Tedford moved, seconded by Mr. Bailey, to approve the application for the beer permit and the manager application and the motion carried unanimously.
