- 2. Review of the proposed permanent access to SR95 for the Emergency Response Training Facility**
 - a. See attachments**
 - b. Combined state and federal facility – 2 buildings, one driveway**
 - c. 25 feet above grade – driveway down near a median cut, 1200 feet east of the Horizon center entrance**
 - d. City Council and TDOT both have to still approve**
 - e. No acceleration lane**
 - f. Ron made a motion to approve the request with the recommendation that an acceleration lane be added**
