



**PUBLIC COMMENTS REQUESTED ON AMENDMENT TO
CDBG ENTITLEMENT PROGRAM
For the
CITY OF OAK RIDGE ANNUAL ACTION PLAN
For the Period July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012
Program Year 2011 / Fiscal Year 2012**

Citizens are asked to comment on an amendment to the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Entitlement Program for the City of Oak Ridge Annual Action Plan for the period of July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012.

Comments will be received for the thirty-day period of January 3, 2012 through February 2, 2012. A public hearing will be held in the Courtroom of the City of Oak Ridge Municipal Building, 200 South Tulane Avenue, during the City Council meeting on Monday January 9, 2012 beginning at 7:00 p.m.

The City of Oak Ridge Annual Action Plan identifies how the city will invest federal CDBG Entitlement funds. These federal resources are programmed through a public planning process to fund community development and housing programs within the city limits of Oak Ridge.

The proposed amendment to the FY2012 Annual Action Plan is for an additional allocation of \$126,000 to be used by the City of Oak Ridge for acquisition and demolition of blighted property within the CDBG Target Area. These funds are derived from previous years unused CDBG grant funds.
