Searching

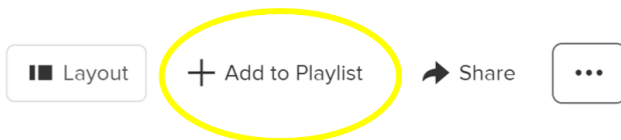
Search for specific topics, skills, or software in the search box or browse under the “Library” dropdown through broad topics and Learning Paths.
