



LEGAL NOTICE

At the direction of the City Manager and in accordance with Article II, Section 2, of the Charter of the City of Oak Ridge, Tennessee, a special meeting of City Council is hereby called for **Tuesday, July 21, 2020 at 6:00 p.m.** in the Municipal Building Courtroom, 200 S. Tulane Avenue. The meeting will be limited to consideration of the following:

- A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ACTIONS FOR THE CONTINUED APPLICATION AND DEVELOPMENT OF THE OAK RIDGE GENERAL AVIATION AIRPORT, INDICATION OF THE TRANSFER TO THE CITY OF OAK RIDGE AS PRIMARY SPONSORING PARTY FROM METROPOLITAN AIRPORT AUTHORITY (MCAA), AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO TAKE ANY NECESSARY ACTIONS TO PURSUE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION (FAA), TENNESSEE AERONAUTICS DIVISION (TAC), AND APPALACHIAN REGIONAL COMMISSION (ARC) IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROJECT.
- A RESOLUTION REQUESTING GOVERNOR BILL LEE ALLOW AUTHORITY TO MUNICIPALITIES TO ISSUE ORDERS OR MEASURES REQUIRING OR RECOMMENDING THE WEARING OF FACE COVERINGS WITHIN THEIR JURISDICTIONS DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC.

The meeting will be open to the public in accordance with Tennessee Open Meetings Act requirements. Due to social distancing requirements and limits on the number of individuals that may gather, space in the Courtroom will be limited. Citizens who do not wish to attend but would like to comment on these items may email their comments to citizencomment@oakridgetn.gov by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, July 20, 2020. Citizen comments will be provided to City Council members prior to the meeting. Citizens should include their name and address for the record just as they do in a normal meeting setting.

The meeting will be streamed live by the City at www.oakridgetn.gov/councilstreaming.aspx. The meeting will also be audio and video recorded and posted on the City's website as soon as possible after the meeting. Due to the Center for Disease Control advisory of social distancing and limitations on gatherings, the City would encourage residents to watch the meeting through one of the methods provided above.

In accordance with the City Charter, matters transacted at this special meeting shall be limited to the subjects recited in the notice of the meeting.
