



### LEGAL NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that the City Council of Oak Ridge, Tennessee, will conduct two (2) public hearings during two (2) special meetings of the City Council which begin at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, June 15, 2020 and Monday, June 22, 2020 in the Courtroom of the Municipal Building at 200 S. Tulane Avenue on the City's proposed FY2021 budget. The public hearings will occur during the consideration of the appropriations ordinance for FY2021. For statutory purposes, the official public hearing will be held at the June 22, 2020 meeting. Following the public hearings, City Council will consider the following ordinance:

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE REVENUE FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2020, BY IMPOSING A TAX ON ALL PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY, FIXING THE RATE OF THE TAX, ADOPTING A BUDGET, AND ADOPTING APPROPRIATIONS.

The meetings will be open to the public in accordance with Tennessee Open Meetings Act requirements. Due to social distancing requirements and limits on the number of individuals that may gather, space in the Courtroom will be limited. Citizens who do not wish to attend but would like to comment on the appropriations ordinance may email their comments to [citizencomment@oakridgetn.gov](mailto:citizencomment@oakridgetn.gov) by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, June 12, 2020 and Friday, June 19, 2020. Citizen comments will be provided to City Council members prior to the meeting. Citizens should include their name and address for the record just as they do in a normal meeting setting.

The meetings will be broadcast live on Comcast Channel 12 and will be streamed live by the City at [www.oakridgetn.gov/councilstreaming.aspx](http://www.oakridgetn.gov/councilstreaming.aspx). The meetings will also be audio and video recorded and posted on the City's website as soon as possible after the meeting. Due to the Center for Disease Control advisory of social distancing and limitations on gatherings, the City would encourage residents to watch the meeting through one of the methods provided above.

Copies of the proposed FY2021 budget will be available for public review at the Oak Ridge Public Library and the City Clerk's Office in the Municipal Building during regular business hours. A budget summary can be viewed on the City's website at [www.oakridgetn.gov](http://www.oakridgetn.gov).
