Notice is hereby given that the City Council of Oak Ridge, Tennessee, will conduct a public hearing virtually at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, February 8, 2021 for the following:

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 2, TITLED "THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF OAK RIDGE, TENNESSEE," BY CREATING A NEW SECTION 9.11, TITLED "SPECIAL RECREATION DISTRICT (SRD)"; AMENDING ARTICLE II, TITLED "DEFINITIONS," TO ADD A DEFINITION OF "MOTOR SPORTS PARK"; AMENDING SECTION 3.18, TITLED "TEMPORARY USE PERMITS," TO CREATE A NEW SUBSECTION (J) FOR OVERFLOW PARKING IN THE SPECIAL RECREATION DISTRICT; AMENDING SECTION 14.03, TITLED "MATRIX," TO ADD THE SPECIAL RECREATION DISTRICT; AMENDING SECTION 14.12, TITLED "SIGNS FOR COMMUNITY BUSINESS DISTRICTS," SUBSECTION 1.(H), TITLED "DEVELOPMENT ENTRY SIGNS," TO ADD THE SPECIAL RECREATION DISTRICT AND TO CREATE A NEW SUBSECTION 1.(I), TITLED "RECREATION FACILITIES"; AMENDING SECTION 16.12, TITLED "USES REQUIRING PLANNING COMMISSION APPROVAL," SUBSECTION (A) TO ADD THE SPECIAL RECREATION DISTRICT; AND AMENDING ARTICLE XIII, TITLED "LANDSCAPING AND DESIGN STANDARDS," FIGURE 13.04(A-B) TO ADD THE SPECIAL RECREATION DISTRICT.

In accordance with Governor Bill Lee's Executive Order Nos. 16, 34, 51, 60, 65, and 71 regarding limiting public gatherings to prevent the further spread of COVID-19 and allowing public meetings to be conducted by electronic means, the meeting will be conducted with Councilmembers participating electronically through video or audio conferencing.

The meeting will be broadcast live on Comcast Channel 12 and will be streamed live by the City at <http://www.oakridgetn.gov/streaming>. Citizens who would like to verbally speak during the public hearing will need to register with their name, address, phone number and email at citizencomment@oakridgetn.gov by Noon on Monday, February 8, 2021. A link to the meeting along with log-in information will be sent to them prior to the meeting.

Meeting electronically and limiting in-person access to the meeting is necessary to protect the public health, safety, and welfare in light of COVID-19.

All citizens are invited to attend and participate in this public hearing.
