

LEGAL NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Oak Ridge, Tennessee, will conduct a public hearing at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, October 10, 2011 in the Courtroom of the Municipal Building at 200 S. Tulane Avenue.

The public hearing will provide an opportunity for residents to provide public input on the Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT) Enhancement Grant and the two (2) projects that are being considered for funding under the grant. The TDOT Enhancement Program provides funding for communities to build or renovate transportation related structures, including sidewalks, bike and pedestrian trails and facilities, and scenic or historical sites.

City Staff is proposing two projects for consideration under the grant: (1) Jackson Square Projects and (2) Corridor Projects from the Oak Ridge Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan.
