

## LEGAL NOTICE

Notice is hereby given of a series of Work Sessions of the Oak Ridge Municipal Planning Commission, for the purpose of studying the conditions of Land Use and Infrastructure and updating the related element of the City's Comprehensive Plan, including policies for long-range growth and land development.

Land Use Work Sessions will be held on the following Thursdays at 5:30 p.m. in the Municipal Court Room and may be subject to cancellation or change: March 10, 24, 31, April 28, May 5. There will also be a Work Session on March 17 at 6 p.m. All dates and agendas will be posted online the Friday prior to each work session at <http://oakridgetn.gov/boardsandcommissions.aspx?Planning-Commission>.

The Planning Commission is tasked with updating the City's long-range Comprehensive Plan (or General Plan). The plan provides the basis for City decisions that influence growth and development over the next 20 years. It includes 1) current characteristics of the community, 2) specific goals for growth or change, and 3) policies for action that can achieve those goals. The first of six distinct, yet interrelated, elements of the plan to be updated is Land Use and Infrastructure.

The Planning Commission will conduct analysis for the Land Use Update during the work sessions, with assistance from City staff and other local resource experts. The update process will include additional public outreach efforts to gather important data and viewpoints from the community.
