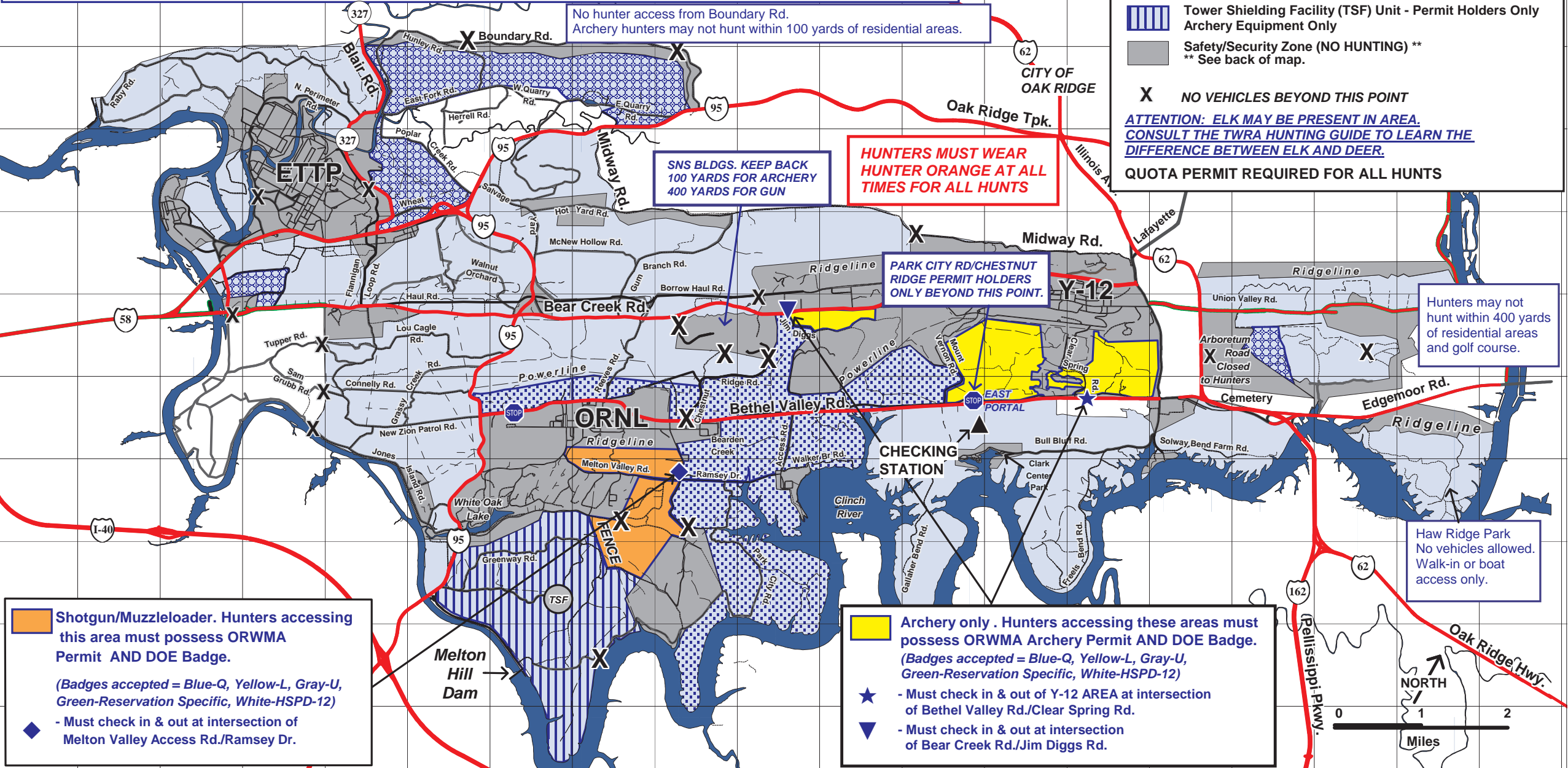

Archery only. Hunters accessing these areas must possess ORWMA Archery Permit AND DOE Badge. (Badges accepted = Blue-Q, Yellow-L, Gray-U, Green-Reservation Specific, White-HSPD-12)

- Must check in & out of Y-12 AREA at intersection of Bethel Valley Rd./Clear Spring Rd.

- Must check in & out at intersection of Bear Creek Rd./Jim Diggs Rd.
