The City of Oak Ridge, Tennessee, will hold a PUBLIC MEETING on January 20, 2021 which begins at 6:00 p.m. (local time) in the Central Service Center, Multi-purpose Room, 100 Woodbury Lane, Oak Ridge, to provide information concerning the application for a Clean Water State Revolving Loan (CWSRF) Fund.

The proposed Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) Project consist of the rehabilitation or replacement of up to 350 manholes, rehabilitation of approximately 10,000 linear feet of sewer mains, evaluation and design of improvements needed for the Emory Valley Sewer Pump Station. The purpose of the project is to reduced I/I in the collection system and improve capacity at the Emory Valley Sewer Pump Station. The continued rehabilitation of the City's sewertreatment, pumping and collection system are needed for compliance with our NPDES permit with the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation.

The City of Oak Ridge has requested CWSRF funding of a \$2,000,000 loan for construction and construction administration with a repayment term of twenty (20) years.
